- 1. To be eligible for the Outstanding Breeding Exhibitor (OBE) in goat, sheep, swine, and beef, exhibitors must participate in the on-site, prodored, virtual Skillathon, and use their own animal in showmanship and the live animal show for each species entered. Youth must exhibit a breeding animal to compete in their corresponding species OBE program.
- 2. Youth do not need to pre-register for the OBE on the Ohio State Fair junior online entry. Exhibitor eligibility for the award will be tracked automatically by the superintendents.
- 3. Goat, sheep, swine, and beef exhibitors must place in their respective class of the live animal, Junior Division show to be eligible for Outstanding Breeding Exhibitor.
- 4. Exhibitors who have achieved the above requirements will have their proctored <u>virtual</u> Skillathon and best breeding showmanship placing within the species combined with their best live animal placing to determine their OBE score.
- 5. Youth will be required to exhibit their knowledge across four (4) subject matter stations in the virtual Skillathon. The four station topics will be posted by June 15 at www.go.osu.edu/osfskillathons on the respective species' Skillathon page.
- 6. Refer to the separate **VIRTUAL BREEDING SKILLATHON** rules for more specific details about that contest.
- 7. If tied for Outstanding Breeding Exhibitor, the following procedure will be used to break ties:
 - 1st: Total score of common Skillathon stations
 - 2nd: Showmanship age division placing
 - 3rd: Live animal class placing
 - 4th: Skillathon Station No. 2 score
 - 5th: Skillathon Station No. 3 score
 - 6th: Skillathon Station No. 4 score
 - 7th: Interview by 4-H Representative, FFA

Representative, and Ohio State Fair Representative.

8. Complaints must be submitted in the form of an email by August 31 to the State 4-H Office at 4HAnimalScience@osu.edu.

AWARDS

Outstanding Breeding Exhibitor age finalists (8/9-18 years old) in goat, sheep, swine, and beef will receive awards determined by the **Ohio State Fair**.

The top <u>five</u> overall Outstanding Breeding Exhibitors in each species category (goat, sheep, swine, and beef) will be selected from the 10 age champions (8/9-18) and will receive cash scholarships from the **Youth Reserve Program**.
