Juror Bio & Statement

Denise Bookwalter is a printmaker and book artist living in Tallahassee, Florida where she is a Professor of Art at Florida State University and Founding Director of Small Craft Advisory Press, a collaborative book arts press. She has exhibited extensively and her artists' books can be found in collections nationally and internationally. The Coffey Residency for the Book Arts at the University of Florida Libraries supported her most recent artists' book, *Sylvan Secrets*.

Growing up in Columbus, Ohio, the Ohio State Fair was synonymous with the dwindling days of summer. I vividly remember the butter cow in its cool

refrigeration, the award-winning vegetables and livestock, the heat and crush of people on the midway, and my fair entries to the fine art and horticultural design categories. Dropping off my entries, I loved seeing the preparations for opening day as entries were arranged for the judges to award the ribbons. I had the honor of winning a few of those ribbons, and this year, I am honored to complete the circle by participating in the behind-the-scenes of the fair. I congratulate all the artists who have submitted their work for this exhibition. I am grateful for the opportunity to be part of the jury team for the Professional Division of Fine Arts at the 2023 Ohio State Fair and have thoroughly enjoyed reviewing the nearly 1000 entries.

The jury process began with an online digital review. During the preliminary review, I considered each piece carefully, considering the artists' integration of concepts and media. The works included landscapes, abstract textiles, figurative sculptures, drawings, and prints. I was drawn to innovative conceptual, design, and media works.

During a second round, my co-juror Arron Foster and I compared and discussed the works from our lists in terms of themes of personal narrative, the COVID experience, novel use of materials, scenes around Ohio, and emerging innovative printmaking processes. When selecting works, we aimed to build an exhibition showcasing the range of talents across the state. Regrettably, there were many works that we were unable to include. I want to thank all artists that submitted work and encourage those not included in this year's show to continue their work and resubmit next year, while keeping in mind that with a new set of jurors come different personal perspectives and preferences.

Congratulations to all the artists. I want to acknowledge each artist's hard work and thank them for sharing their works for this exhibition. Thank you to all of the behind-the-scenes people that make this exhibition happen, especially Flint Garrabrant, and his organization, care, and empathy in directing the jurying process and the exhibition. Thank you to my co-juror and fellow printmaker, Arron Foster, for his patience, dedication, and compassion during the juror process. I enjoyed our Zoom chats spread over four days, discussing our preferences and developing the exhibition.

Finally, to complete the circle, congratulations to all the ribbon winners and especially to the Best of Show, Evie Zimmer for *Wonderlust*.

Juror Bio & Statement

Arron Foster received his Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Printmaking and Art Education from East Carolina University in Greenville, NC, and his Master of Fine Arts degree in Printmaking and Book Arts from the University of Georgia, Athens, Georgia. His prints and installations have been in notable exhibitions at respected national and international galleries, museums, and art centers. Recent honors include mounting solo exhibitions at the Dayton Society of the Arts, Akron Soul Train Gallery, and Hiram University in Hiram, Ohio, and participating in the International Youth Printmaking Invitational Exhibition in Changsha, China. Foster has been the recipient of competitive grants from the Ohio Arts Council, Kent State University, the University of Georgia, and the Southern Graphics

Council International. He is currently an Assistant Professor of Art at Kent State University at Stark in North Canton, Ohio.

Firstly, I would like to express my gratitude for being asked to jury for the Ohio State Fair's 2023 Professional Division Arts Competition. And wish to congratulate all of the artists involved with this exhibition.

As a juror for this year's Ohio State Fair Exhibition, I was fortunate to view a wide range of works representing a diversity of technical and conceptual approaches to art and image making. The sheer volume and quality of the submissions made the task of choosing 250 pieces a difficult one, as there were an abundance of riches to choose from.

Throughout the process, I tried to focus on this year's print centric theme and choose works that offered something special due to their overall technical, material and or conceptual sophistication. I also focused on work that clearly demonstrated a unique personal voice or vision.

Throughout the process many works caught my attention for various and contradictory reasons. In grappling with the volume of qualified submissions, I strove to make the jury process fair by balancing my selections along technical, formal, or experimental lines.

Regrettably, as the process advanced, many qualified works were left out. Due to the need to present a diverse and balanced exhibition, the jury decided to exhibit only two works by any artist unless each piece was small and made a much stronger statement as a group.

It is my hope that artists whose works were not chosen for this show will see the challenges inherent in the jurying process and continue to submit work for future juried exhibitions.

Finally, I would like to thank my co-juror Denise Bookwalter whose conceptual intellect, formal awareness and attention to detail were integral as we worked (virtually) across varying time zones to complete this task. I would also like to thank Flint Garrabrant for coordinating our efforts and to the staff at the Ohio State Fair for hanging the show.

I hope that this years audience enjoys the show as much as I enjoyed looking at the images and selecting the exhibition. As an artist who lives and works in Ohio, it is inspiring to see that art is alive and well in our State.

Juror Bio & Statement

Eliana Calle Saari is a Colombian-born artist whose award-winning work has been widely exhibited nationally and internationally. She earned a degree in Fashion Design from her hometown of Medellin before moving to the United States to continue her studies where she earned BA degrees in Art and Spanish from Otterbein University, followed by an MFA in Printmaking from The Ohio State University.

Her printmaking practice draws from traditional Colombian storytelling with its blend of evocative description and Magic Realism. Calle Saari creates series of monumental woodcuts printed on lush paper, diaphanous silk, and patterned cotton, as well as meticulous constructed artist's books that contain prints which intimately engage the viewer and evoke universal folkloric stories.

Calle Saari is a professional teaching artist and currently a faculty member in the Art Department at Ohio Dominican University and an adjunct professor at her alma mater, Otterbein University. Her work has been recognized through numerous solo exhibitions, awards, and residencies. In 2008, Calle Saari was awarded an Ohio Arts Council Artist-in-Residence Exchange in Dresden, Germany and, in both 2016, 2017, 2022 her printmaking won awards in the Ohio State Fair Fine Arts Exhibition.

As the juror for this year's Amateur division of the Ohio State Fair Fine Arts Exhibition, I cannot help but reminisce about my own journey as an artist. A little over twenty years ago, right here at the Ohio State Fair Fine Arts Exhibition, my work was being exhibited for the very first time in a non-academic setting. That experience holds a special place in my heart. Little did I know then that this annual event would become an integral part of my artistic career.

When I received the invitation to be the juror for this year's Amateur division, I was delighted. I knew that this would be an opportunity to witness the blossoming of beginners and those who create art purely for the joy it brings. The Amateur division represents a realm of untamed creativity, where individuals pour their hearts and souls into their artwork, unhindered by external pressures or expectations. It was particularly refreshing to see not only the quality of the work but also the sheer sense of freedom that emanated from each piece.

Throughout the jurying process, I was impressed by the quality of the submissions. The level of talent and dedication displayed by the artists in this division was inspiring. I must admit that it made my task quite challenging and humbling. The decision-making process was no easy feat, as each piece held its own unique charm and merit.

To those whose work has been selected for exhibition, I offer my heartfelt congratulations. Your talent and artistic expression have shone through, and your presence in this show is well-deserved. May this recognition fuel your creative spirit and propel you towards further success on your artistic journey. However, to those whose work was not chosen this time around, I want to emphasize the importance of perseverance and belief in your own artistic vision. Rejection can be disheartening, but it should never be a deterrent. I encourage you to continue believing in the power of your work. Keep creating, keep experimenting, and keep pushing the boundaries of your artistic abilities. Consider submitting your work again next year, explore local art shows, and seek out opportunities to showcase your talent.
